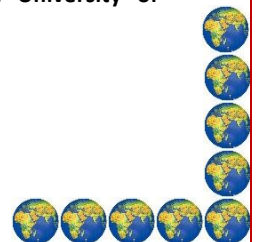

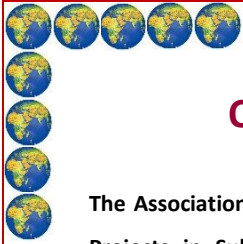

## OUR ACTIVITY

The Association supports Development Cooperation Projects in Sub-Saharan Africa, Asia, Central and Latin America. These projects are implemented in form of co-management and partnership with local educational structures.

### RESEARCH SCHOLARSHIPS

addressed to young graduates recommended by their universities. The research topics take into account the personal interests of each candidate and the country social-politics orientation. This is to allow the researches to be relevant to the political, social, educational priorities of each context.

### PROFESSIONAL TRAINING

in the educational, social, health and agricultural field, to be realized in local training structures. Notably, projects linked to social cooperatives and to entrepreneurial activities are of priority.

## SEMINARS

In collaboration with the Universities and the other partners, the Association organizes research and training seminars on issues related to development, human rights, international cooperation, Education for all and lifelong learning, addressed to the civil society and university managers, NGOs and cooperatives directors, educational actors of formal and non-formal system, social and entrepreneurial actors.
